Journeyman License Renewals

After three years, a renewal packet will be sent out to the journeymen whose licenses are up for renewal. The instruction sheet along with the appropriate "open book" renewal exam(s) will be mailed to the license holder's most current address on file a month prior to the expiration date of the current license.

 Failure to pass any renewal examination will require the applicant to retake and pass the initial Journeyman exam.

Contractors:

If the applicant has a current Arizona Contractor's License and is applying for a first time Journeyman license, no exam is required. They need only complete an application and pay the appropriate Journeyman license fee. If they wish to renew their Journeyman license, they are required to take the renewal exam and pay the appropriate renewal fee(s).

Note: Any license that is issued based upon fraudulent information will be voided immediately and appropriate legal action will be taken.

All work performed on plumbing and mechanical systems where a permit is required per city of Phoenix Building Construction Code (PBCC), Section 105, is required to be performed by a licensed Journeyman or by an Apprentice per PBCC, Section 119.

Apprentice License

An Apprentice must work under the supervision of a licensed Journeyman or Arizona State licensed contractor at all times work is being performed. The licensed Journeyman or state licensed contractor is responsible for the work of the Apprentice.

To obtain a city of Phoenix Apprentice license, the applicant must:

- Complete an application.
- Present a current picture I.D.
- Provide a <u>notarized</u> statement on company letterhead signed by a company official verifying that the individual works for their company.
- Pay the appropriate fee(s).

A Journeyman is a person skilled in an area of work covered by PBCC, Section 119 with sufficient work experience and code knowledge to pass the Journeyman test. The Journeyman is capable of performing work covered by their Journeyman license and supervising the work of Apprentices.
